**Notification No 81 (RE – 2013)/2009-2014**

**New Delhi, Dated: 13 June, 2014**

**Subject:- Exemption to Bhutan from the application of export bans by India on export of Milk Powder, Wheat, Edible Oils, Pulses and Non Basmati Rice.**

S.O. (E) In exercise of powers conferred by Section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992) read with paragraph 1.3 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2009-2014, as amended from time to time, the Central Government hereby exempts export of the following items to Bhutan from any export ban:

- (i) Milk powder
- (ii) Wheat
- (iii) Edible oil
- (iv) Pulses
- (v) Non-basmati rice

2. Effect of this Notification:

Export of above items to Bhutan will be exempted from any ban and without any quantitative restrictions. This supersedes earlier Notification No. 87 of 05.12.2011 & Notification No. 104 of 05.03.2012.
