ADVISORY FOR EXPORT OF QUALITY WHEAT FROM INDIA

1. Demand of Indian wheat is increasing in the international market and it is important that we supply only good quality of wheat strictly as per the importing country requirements and ensure that no complaints are received. Exporters are advised to take necessary measures in export of quality wheat from India.
2. Sourcing/procurement of quality raw material from the identified production area in the respective States/clusters.
3. Seeking Registration cum Membership Certificate from APEDA. For seeking APEDA registration may access Registration Procedure under Corporate Information icon at APEDA website (www.apeda.gov.in)
4. Fulfillment of import requirements of the importing country:
 - Implementation of Food Safety Measures and Good Manufacturing & Hygiene Practices.
 - Registration with importing countries, if required (e.g. for export of wheat to Egypt, GASC is a nodal agency with public procurement of essential commodities in Egypt Indian exporters will have to register with General Authority for supply and Commodities (GASC) through local agents or their representative officers in Cairo first to supply to GASC).
 - Fulfillment of Pesticide testing as per the parameters mentioned by the importing countries. In order to attain quality of the produce to be exported, APEDA has recognized 231 labs across India to provide services of testing to wide range of products exporters.
 - Certificate of Conformity (COC), if required by the importing countries etc.
 - May please ensure that the produce is free from dust and pests etc. and meet all the specifications provided by the importing countries.
5. Development of Packaging as per the requirement of the importing country.



6. As per the advice of the Ministry of Railways, to avoid any possible delays to wagon and consequent detention charges, all exporters are advised to load wheat in standard bags.
7. Seeking Phyto Sanitary Certificate from Plant Quarantine Department. May also ensure, if any additional information is required to be mentioned in PSC from the concerned country.
8. It is needless to say that if any complaint is received against any exporter strict action will be taken as deemed fit under the circumstances.
